### Age-Focused Classes

**Journey Class**—mostly ages 45-60.

### Wednesday Nights

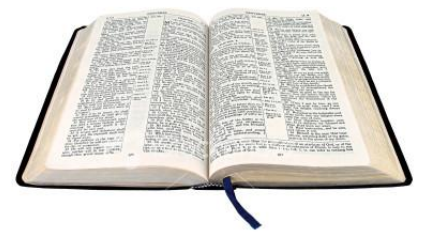
#### **General Adult** (B100)
