Adult Bible Classes, Sundays, 9:15-10:10 a.m.

Fellowship Group (B100) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 50 and older.

The class will begin a study of "Romans". The group will be taught by a rotation of teachers and is open to all.

SonRise class (B201-204) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 40 and older.

The class will study "A Christian Response to Current Events". It will be taught by Des Steyn & Dennis Tom, and is open to all.

Journey class (B202) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 45-60.

The class will study the book "Muscle and a Shovel" by James Shank. The class will be taught by Carl Ball, Bill Crawford, Ray Fuller, and Dr. Bob Mullen, and is open to all.

Seekers class (C200) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 20s-30s, mostly with younger children.

The class continues an in-depth, interactive study of the book of Isaiah. This class will be taught by Gary Pence, and is open to all.

Faithful Families class (C201-203) *Demographic:* Mostly ages early 30s to late 40s, with middle to high school-aged children.

The class will study "Jesus and Me", with materials from several authors and Scriptures. The class will be taught by David Byrnes, Aaron Green, and Coker Roswell, and is open to all.

College/Young Professionals class (C202-204) *Demographic:* Ages 19 to late 20s.

The class will select a new topic and new teacher each week.

General Adult class (D103-104) *Demographic:* Intergenerational.

The class continues "The Gospel of John – "The Deity of Christ". We will see an interesting, distinctive picture of Christ, in full harmony with the other Gospels, but adding to the Bible's revelation of Jesus, the God-man. This class is taught by Steve Croft, and is open to all.

General Adult class (W101) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 50s and older.

The class continues in the book of Isaiah, and then will go into Jeremiah. This class will be taught by Don Plemons and is open to all.

Singles class (W102) *Demographic:* Singles of all ages.

The class will decide on its study and teachers by next Sunday.

Adult Bible Classes, Wednesdays, 7:00-7:55 p.m.

General Adult class (B100) *Demographic:* Mostly ages 50 and older.

The class begins a study of the book of Philipians. The study will help us understand the importance of keeping our focus on God and, then everything else falls into its proper place. This class will be taught by Don Davis and Bill Lawrence and is open to all.

General Adult Class (B201) *Demographic:* Intergenerational

The class will continue to explore the series "Applied Christianity-Preparing People to Serve". A new ministry or topic will be featured each week, with introductory material and guest interviews with people who show that ministry or topic in their walk with God. The class is taught by Dr. Bob Mullen, and is open to all.

Couples' Bible Study (C100). *Demographic:* Mostly married adults.

The class will be a less formal study and prayer time for couples to be together in learning God's word. This class will be taught Dr. Dave Sager and Quincy DeQueemani, and is open to all.

Women's Bible Class (C201). *Demographic:* Women.

The class will then study a series of topics with several teachers.

College/Young Professionals class (C202-204) *Demographic:* Ages 19 to late 20s.
