SPECIAL WEDNESDAY CLASS on "Parenting"

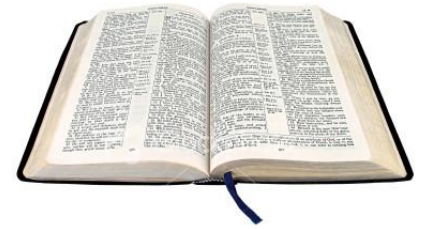
Begins September 3rd,
